In its 80th year, The Sheridan-Wyo-Rodeo (The WYO) just keeps getting better. This year, for the first time, The WYO is designated as one of the 22 prestigious Million Dollar Tour Rodeos on the circuit of over 600 Professional Rodeo Cowboys of America (PRCA) sanctioned rodeos.

The WYO is more than just a rodeo; it’s a weeklong community celebration with something for everyone.

Rodeo fans are thrilled at each of the four night performances that are jam-packed with action. The exciting World Championship Indian Relay Race is followed by eight rough stock and timed rodeo events. The best contestants “cowboy up” on quality stock supplied by Sankey Pro Rodeo.

Rodeo Week begins with outdoor concerts and are followed by a boot kick off contest, the Kiwanis Pancake Breakfast and Duck Races and the Beds Along the Big Horns bed race down Main Street just before the Rodeo Parade. After each rodeo performance rodeo fans can dance the night away on Main Street in downtown Sheridan. Rodeo week ends with a tail gate party at the Big Horn Equestrian Center.
